The meeting was called to order at 6:11 p.m. at the Neighborhood Co-op. The Treasurer collected dues from new members, Bonnie Juul and Beau Henson and returning member Brent Ritzel.

Y. Presley noted that the purpose of the meeting was to revive the organization. What do we want the neighborhood to be?

It was noted that the City is hiring a Public Relations Officer. Also, there is a new program hoping to bring reserve medical officers into the area and they will also bring in a team to bring in construction "battalions" and demolish houses as needed.

Various issues in the neighborhood were discussed and it was clear that there is a need for this organization to be active.

Y. Presley noted that the business of the Northwest Carbondale Neighborhood Association is to be carried out by a Board consisting of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, and five to seven at-large members, and that the Board may fill vacancies as they occur.

It was agreed that the new Board members would form a committee to organize the Annual Meeting in the Fall at which the election of Officers and Board Members for an updated and more active NCNA will occur. Current Board members will participate and help all they can to ensure a smooth transition.
